WHAT IS SLASH?

Slash is natural debris like tree limbs, prunings, and pine cones. If not cleared, it can increase fire risk around your home. Removing slash and creating **defensible space** is one of the most important steps you can take to protect your property from wildfire.

INFORMATION

Shingletown Transfer Station

(Ritts Mill Rd. & Hwy 44)

Follow on-site staff directions.

Do NOT go to the main transfer area.

FREE for all Shingletown residents and property owners.

✓ **Accepted:** brush, tree limbs, yard trimmings (keep woody materials separated from leaf and needle litter).

✗ **Not Accepted:** logs over 20", lumber or construction debris, dirt, rocks, palm, oleander, poison oak, or trash.

Loads will be inspected before unloading.
